

Some frequently asked questions about the Halloween Run

What time does the event start?

The spookiness begins at 2pm with registration, followed by a thriller warm up at 2.50pm and the run will begin at 3pm. The venue is Worcester Countryside Centre, Wildwood drive, WR5 2LG.

There is ample parking across a few sites and you will be directed to them when coming up Wildwood drive.

Is there an age limit for young runners?

This event is suitable for all age groups. It will depend on the weather leading up to and on the day whether buggies will be able to navigate the course, but we will give you plenty of warning if not. This event is not a race, however, we will ask those who wish to run to come to the front of the starting line. Children aged 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. (Said adult can accompany no more than three minors.)

What facilities will there be at Worcester Countryside Centre?

Parking: Free parking will be available across a few sites and you will be directed to these when approaching up Wildwood Drive.

Toilets: There are free public toilets on site including disabled and baby changing facilities.

Refreshments: Each Halloween runner will receive a free bottle of water once completing the run, we advise that you bring a water bottle along as there will be an opportunity to fill this up - plus you can purchase hot and cold drinks and snacks.

Do I have to run the route? How far is it?

The Halloween Family Fun Run is about exactly that, having fun. You can run, walk, skip, or dance your way around one or two laps of the 2.5km route.

Is The Halloween Run a timed event?

No, it's definitely not a race. We suggest self-timing for anyone wanting a finish time. After all, this isn't a competitive run!

What do I wear?

You need to wear your best fancy dress, remember there are prizes! Wear suitable footwear for running on a cross country terrain such as an old pair of trainers and we aware, costumes may get slightly messy.
