Further Information

- Date of Event:** Saturday 8th September 2018
Please note that in the event of bad weather, Take Flight Aviation reserve the right to cancel the event and reschedule for as soon as possible afterwards. This could be as soon as the next day so you might want to keep the whole weekend free.
- Time:** Flights will be taking place throughout the day from 9am to 5pm
Once participants have registered with us, we will get in touch prior to the day to give you an estimated time slot.
- You don't have to stay at the airfield all day - Stratford is very close by and worth a visit – but you are welcome to stay and share in the excitement of others taking part.

- Cost:** A £50 non-refundable registration fee is payable upon sign-up which is taken off the final loop cost

Payment & Fundraising

- Your £50 non-refundable registration fee is payable upon registration
- If you are self-paying for your flight, you will be asked to pay £100 at the airfield by cash or card after your flight.
- If you have pledged to raise the minimum £395 you must ensure that this is with St Richard's either online or offline by 10th February, or be able to show you have pledges totalling this amount.

What to bring on the day

- Please complete the Take Flight Aviation Temporary Membership Form enclosed in this pack and bring it with you on the day
- Please dress appropriately for the weather. It may be chilly and possibly windy.
- Family and friends to watch you achieve your feat!

Guidelines from Take Flight

- Maximum height for participants, 6ft 3in and maximum weight 15 stone
- Do not fly if pregnant and consult your GP if you are taking any medication or suffer from any illness that may affect your flight, e.g. heart complaint
- Children 16yrs and under need written consent from parents/guardians
- Participants take part at their own risk. Take Flight Aviation carries £4million third party and passenger liability insurance
- Passengers must be able to get themselves into and out of the aircraft unaided
- No alcohol to be consumed before the flight and no food or drink allowed on board the aircraft
- Remove loose jewellery
- We recommend not flying on an empty stomach, but advise you not to eat a minimum of 2 hours beforehand
- The flight experience will last approximately 20-30 minutes in total

What will happen on the day?

- We will ask you to arrive approximately 40-60 minutes prior to your flight time. This will allow you time to check in with us, sign any paperwork and prepare for your flight
- Hotdogs and hot and cold drinks are available to purchase
- Your flight will last 20-30 minutes, which will include a demonstration of aerobatic loops and rolls which will take your breath away!
- A Go-Pro will record your entire flight and we will give you a certificate as a keepsake.
