

St Richard's Hospice Fundraising Safeguarding principles at events – children and young persons

St Richard's is very grateful for your support. As part of our approach to professional fundraising we ask that when assessing the risks of any fundraising activities being planned that you give special attention to the welfare and safety of children and young people (ie all those under 18 years old) this should be a paramount consideration.

- a) Treat all children and young people with respect and value their views and wishes.
- b) Always seek parental consent before children are involved in or attend an event.
- c) If the person is under 16, please ensure that parents or carers or other responsible adults attend the event with the child or young person.
- d) If the young person is between the ages of 16-18 they may take part in certain events with parental consent.
- e) At any event do not get into a situation where you are alone with a child/young person outside of the sight and hearing of other people.
- f) Do not remain in contact with a child/young person outside of the fundraising event or activity and always with the knowledge and consent of the parent/carer.
- g) Only keep the minimum amount of information needed about the child/young person and ensure you comply with data protection in storing and using the information.
- h) Always obtain parental/carer consent to photos/film of young children by using the approved documentation held by the Communications Manager.
- i) Where possible, seek references and checks on people and organisations who provide services at your events.
- j) Always report any concerns you may have about a child or young person to a member of the fundraising team and/or the Fundraising Director.
- k) Always report any allegations made about you to a member of the fundraising team and /or the Fundraising Director who will escalate any concerns to the Hospice Safeguarding team.
- I) Seek advice from the St Richard's hospice fundraising team if you require any further clarification or assistance.
