Date, time and venue:

Saturday 10th February, registration from 4.45pm and set off from 5.15pm.
National Trust Croome, High Green, Worcester WR8 9DW.

Where can I park?

Free parking is available at the venue however spaces are limited so please do car share where possible.

How far is the route?

1.5-mile route around the picturesque National Trust Croome parkland.

What age do I need to be to participate?

People of all ages are able to participate in this event. All 16-year olds and under will need to be accompanied by an adult.

Are the routes pushchair friendly?

Yes, the route is pushchair friendly but please note there are some small hills and can be quite muddy.

Are the routes wheelchair friendly?

Yes, the route is wheelchair friendly, but we would advise pre-booking one of the National Trust free mobility scooters. The route does have some small hills and can be muddy so use of the mobility scooters would make the route easier to manage.

Are dogs allowed?

Yes, but they will need to be kept on a short lead at all times and they must be well-behaved. Dog owners must be responsible and clean up after their dog.

Will there be marshals along the route?

Yes, there will be marshals positioned in certain places along the route in high visibility jackets.

Will snacks and refreshments be available on the day?

Yes, the on-site café will be open serving refreshments and light snacks. Participants are also encouraged to bring their own hot drink flasks for use in the café.

What should I wear?

Wear suitable and comfortable walking clothing and wrap up warm! It's likely to be quite cold so make sure you have plenty of layers including hats, gloves and scarfs. Wear trainers, wellies or walking shoes and bring a waterproof (breathable recommended) – after all it is England.

What do I need to take with me on the day?

A bottle of water, warm clothing and a torch/head torch.

Although lanterns are provided for the walk lighting is limited so we would ask you to bring a torch or a head torch along with you if you'd feel more comfortable.

What do I get on completion?

The lantern you are given at the event is then yours to keep and take home.

You'll get the chance to experience National Trust Croome and its parkland lit up at dusk.

Do I have to raise sponsorship money?

We encourage all participants to fundraise as much as possible, perhaps you are walking in memory of a loved one.

It is the additional money raised through public donations that makes a huge difference to the individuals and families we support and care for. There is no minimum sponsorship/donation amount, any money raised is greatly appreciated and helps us continue to care.
