Where is the event held?

Spetchley Park Gardens, Spetchley, Worcester, WR5 1RS

What time does the film start?

The outdoor showing of Grease will start at 7.30pm with gates opening up at 6.30pm to allow you to find a space and get comfortable.

Is there parking available?

There is ample free parking available but please do car share where possible.

Can I bring my own food and drink?

Yes, you are welcome to bring a picnic with snacks and drinks. There will also be a bar and food onsite available to purchase from, please bring cash in case of any signal problems. There is no cash point onsite.

No BBQs are allowed on site and no glass.

Please remember to take any rubbish away with you to help keep the gardens tidy

Can I bring alcohol?

Yes, but please drink responsibly. There will also be a bar onsite. Anyone acting drunk, rowdy and disorderly will be asked to leave.

Is seating provided?

No. Please bring your own camping chair/picnic blanket to use for the duration of the event. Please do not bring tables.

What happens if it rains?

We will still go ahead in the event of rain! Please ensure to check the weather forecast on the day of the screening and come prepared for any conditions. In the event of rain, we'll embrace the Great British weather so dress appropriately and have fun!

In the event of strong winds and torrential rain, the event will take place the following week, Saturday 7th September. If there is any concern regarding the weather, we will inform all ticket holders via email but otherwise, it can be assumed that the event is going ahead as planned.

Can I bring my dog?

No sorry, with the exception of assistance dogs, no animals are allowed. If you plan to bring an assistance dog we'd be grateful if you could inform us when you book.

Can I bring a tent or gazebo?

No. Tents and gazebos are not permitted as they block the view for others.

Do I need to print off my ticket?

If you would prefer to yes, otherwise, displaying your ticket barcode on a smartphone is fine.

Are children allowed?

Grease is rated a PG film which means children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

Are tickets refundable?

No, but we can change the name on the ticket.

If due to storms the event can no longer go ahead it will be postponed to the following week (Saturday 7th September). If you cannot make this new date then a refund will be offered.

Is the event assessible for wheelchair and pushchairs?

Yes, the site is largely flat, and paths are either gravel or grass. There are also mobility scooters that can be hired from Spetchley Gardens. Please contact them directly to organise this.

Do I have to dress up?

No, but dressing up is encouraged as there will be prizes for the best dressed!

Can I smoke or vape?

You cannot smoke or vape in the viewing area of the event as we want everyone to have the best experience possible. There will be a designated smoking/vaping area.

Can I walk around the gardens?

You can enjoy the area in which the cinema experience is taking place by the lake and house but unfortunately due to health and safety reasons you can't walk around the gardens as it will be very dark when the sun sets.

Are there toilets onsite?

Yes there are toilets onsite as well as two with disabled access.
